Saturday 18th May

- 10.30 12.00 Registration at South Side Uniting Church, 440 Goonoo Goonoo Road, South Tamworth. Tea/Coffee and light lunch will be provided.
- 12.30 02.00 Guided Tour of Tamworth Power Station Museum, 216 Peel Street (Corner Peel & Darling Streets). Parking at rear, access from Darling Street.

 Tamworth claims to have been the first town in the Southern Hemisphere with electric street lighting. This museum captures this heritage.

 An entry fee of \$3 per person to be paid at the venue.
- 02.30 04.00 Visit Tamworth Regional Art Gallery, 466 Peel Street (Opposite JT Fossey Ford)
 View the Archibald Prize 2023 Finalists plus a back-room gallery tour.
 The Archibald Prize is awarded annually to the best portrait, 'preferentially of some man or woman distinguished in art, letters, science or politics, painted by any artist resident in Australasia'. This open competition is judged by the trustees of the Art Gallery of NSW. Parking at rear of the gallery accessed from either Peel or Hill Streets.
 There is no entry fee.
- 05.00 09.00 Tamworth Regional Astronomy and Science Centre, 166 Piper Street
 Commencing with a Spit Roast Dinner
 This centre houses some significant telescopes, cameras and scientific displays.
 Expect to experience a fascinating evening that includes some star gazing (weather dependent).
 \$40 per person including dinner, guided tour and star gazing.
